

**Sub: Approval of LL.B. 5 years programme.**

Dear Sir,


As you are aware the Legal Education Committee of the Pakistan Bar Council considered the above cited matter in its meeting held on 09-12-2017 at Karachi, in your presence. The decision of the Committee taken in the matter, is reproduced hereunder, for your information:-

*"Prof. Dr. Qammaruddin Bohra, Dean Faculty of Law, Hamdard University, Karachi, was present.*

*(ii) The above cited letter of Hamdard School of Law, Karachi seeking accreditation/approval of 5 years LL.B. programme was considered. The learned representative of the Hamdard University was apprised that the foremost requirement of the "PBC Legal Education Rules, 2015", is that the Universities imparting legal education will switch over to the 5 years LL.B. programme in place of 3 years LL.B. programme and so are essentially required to conduct classes only for 5 years LL.B. programme and no University is supposed to give admission to students for 3 years LL.B. after enforcement of said Rules.*

*(iii) However, after due consideration, the Committee appreciated that the Hamdard University has started imparting legal education since 2016 on LL.B. 5 years programme. It was, therefore, emphasized that the University will ensure that 5 years LL.B. programme will strictly be in accordance with syllabus as designed by the Higher Education Commission duly endorsed by the Pakistan Bar Council. The University shall also ensure forthwith stoppage of the 3 years LL.B. programme which is no more permissible under the "PBC Legal Education Rules, 2015."*

Dear Sir,

Please be informed that your letter No. HU/REG/00/3131 dated 28-10-2000, was considered by the Legal Education Committee in its last meeting held on 03-02-2001. The decision taken by the Committee in the matter, duly approved by the Pakistan Bar Council in its 130<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24-03-2001, is reproduced hereunder for your information please:-

"The Committee was of the view that semester system would be more useful for law students and it would help better scrutiny and monitoring of students by the Teachers. The Committee, therefore, recommends to the Pakistan Bar Council that recognition may be accorded to the Hamdard University and its law courses as provided under Section 26 (i) (c) (iii) of the Legal Practitioners and Bar Councils Act, 1973."

- (ii) The Council after receipt of such recommendation and after giving opportunity of hearing, may derecognize such University or Degree Awarding Institution and order deletion of its name from the First or Second Schedule as the case may be.
- (iii) The Council or the Committee may, as the case may be, associate any member of a Provincial Bar Council during the course of any inspection or inquiry.

8. Any University or Degree Awarding Institution aggrieved by the order of derecognition, may file a review petition within 30 days of the receipt of the order of derecognition before the Council, accompanied by a fee of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupee Fifty Thousand only).
